All the typefaces are innovative designs by Nick Shinn, with full character sets and kerning, available for both Mac and Windows.

The idea behind this collection was to produce a series of entirely new and original designs that harness certain attributes of more traditional typefaces, but without merely copying or reviving them. In other words, a set of instant classics.

Nick Shinn was born in London in 1952 and moved to Toronto in 1977, where he spent the Eighties as art director of an advertising agency. Since 1991 he has divided his time between publication design and typeface development.

Nick Shinn's previous type designs include Fontesque, Merlin and Oneleigh for FontFont; Paradigm for the Creative Alliance range and Shinn Sans for Red Rooster Typefounders.

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
